### A bible study on the weekly Mass Readings

Most of the Liturgy of the Word is comprised of readings from Scripture. On Sundays and Holy Days there are three Scripture readings. During most of the year, the first reading is selected from the Old Testament and the second reading is chosen from one of the New Testament letters. The pinnacle of the Liturgy of the Word is the reading of the Gospel. The Gospels tell of the life, ministry, and evangelization of Christ.

In the Liturgy of the Word, the Church nourishes the people of God. The Scriptures are the word of God, written under the encouragement of the Holy Spirit. In the Scriptures, God speaks to us, leading us along the path to redemption.

God speaks to us through many means, including through the Sunday Scripture readings. Come share your experiences with God and the Scripture with other faith filled parishioners.
